Next meeting will be held on May 6 and the upcoming Board Meeting will be on April 13.

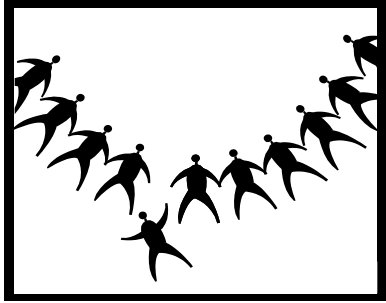
The Greeters for the May meeting will be Don and Dee Elliott.

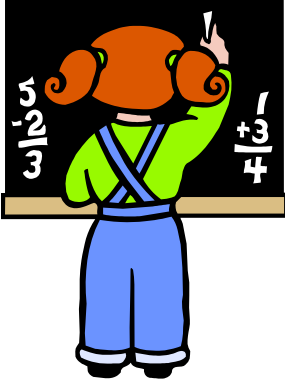
## FOOD PANTRY DONATIONS

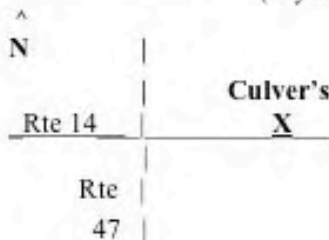

This is the latest information we have as we prepare for the 2011 NCCC Convention. The convention team continues to meet twice each month, one time just Larry Pagliaro and I, and the other time on a conference call with other team leaders on items that are in process and happening now.

Good news we have for everyone is the convention logos have been finalized and the merchandise team of Nancy Bailey and Diana Haack have a sample shirt to show to the Steering Committee and the Midwest Regional Governors at the up coming Regional and National meeting this month. A lot of hard work has gone into this from Perry Scarsellato designing the logos to Nancy and Diana producing merchandise. I had an idea for a convention logo last year and told Perry about it and he read my mind and produced a logo just as I had imagined it. Make sure you thank them if you see them for the fine job they have done so far. Look for an order form soon on the MWR website for early orders for MWR members. This way you'll have a 2011 shirt right after the Florida convention to show off.

Our chairperson list is filling up fast. There are only several spots left to fill. Three of the party nights with themes have clubs hosting them.
