Greetings Sunburst Members,

As we head toward Labor Day, we can pretty much call the 2020 competition season a complete washout in the Midwest Region. Almost all competitive events have been cancelled and the only event that remains on the calendar is a 5 day rally, sponsored by the Wisconsin Corvette Club on September 19th. All of us are hoping that the 2021 season will not be a repeat of 2020.

The Governors in the Midwest Region continue to meet monthly, via teleconferencing. At our August meeting a decision was made to cancel the MWR's autocross events, which serve as a major fund raising event for the region. Although the decision wasn't made at that meeting, this will definitely influence the decision to cancel all championships and the MWR banquet. The Governors also discussed a few proposed rule changes for the 2022 rule book. Those rules that affect the MWR include:

- A proposal to increase the number of sanction numbers per club, from 10 to 17. MWR Governors do not support this change.
- A proposal to limit the number of sanction numbers on a given day from 7 to 5. MWR Governors support this change.

At this time, the MWR Governor's will continue to meet monthly via teleconference. In September we will begin the process of planning for the 2021 competition season. Sunburst is hoping to still be involved in 2 autocross events at Mc Henry County College. If you have any suggestions for competitive events for next year, give me a call and we'll figure out how to incorporate them into our planning for next year.

Hopefully my future messages will sound a bit more hopeful as we plan for 2021. Stay healthy and keep your sense of humor.

1,750,000 CORVETTE – PRODUCED AUGUST 14, 2020



The 1.75 Millionth Corvette was produced at the Bowling Green Kentucky assembly line Friday August 14th and will be raffled off at the National Corvette Museum Friday September 4th. There were 1500 raffle tickets available for the 1.75 Millionth Corvette at a cost of \$200 per ticket.

On June 30, 1953 the first Corvette officially rolled off the assembly line in Flint, Mich. – a Polo White convertible with red interior. Only 300 Corvettes were produced in 1953 and all 300 were identical – Polo White with red interior. Sixty-seven-years later the 1.75 Millionth Corvette was produced on the Bowling Green assembly line, also white with red interior.

In 1992 the one millionth Corvette and in 2009 the 1.5 millionth Corvette, both white with red interior convertibles, reside at the National Corvette Museum, becoming famous years after being produced when they fell victim to a 2014 sinkhole inside the Museum. The one millionth Corvette has since been restored by General Motors and both cars can be viewed in the National Corvette Museum.

The 1.75 millionth Corvette, an Arctic White Coupe with Adrenaline Red interior, will only temporarily call the National Corvette Museum its home as it is used in the fundraising raffle by the Museum.

“We are appreciative of Chevrolet for aligning the production of one of our Corvette raffle cars so that it would become this milestone in production,” shared Dr. Sean Preston, President and CEO of the National Corvette Museum. “It’s exciting that in just 11 years Bowling Green Assembly has produced 250,000 Corvettes. No other sports car can claim that kind of production volume or enthusiast following.”

The Corvette will be raffled on Friday, September 4 at 3pm CT as part of the Museum's 26th Anniversary Celebration event. In addition to being an Arctic White Coupe with Adrenaline Red interior the 1.75 millionth Corvette features the Z51 performance package, 3LT equipment group, 5-trident spoke machined-face sterling silver aluminum wheels, engine appearance package, front lift adjustable height with memory and more. The car will be delivered to the lucky raffle winner via the Corvette Museum Delivery program, also referred to as option code R8C when ordering a new Corvette, which provides a red carpet V.I.P. experience for the winner and up to three accompanying guests.

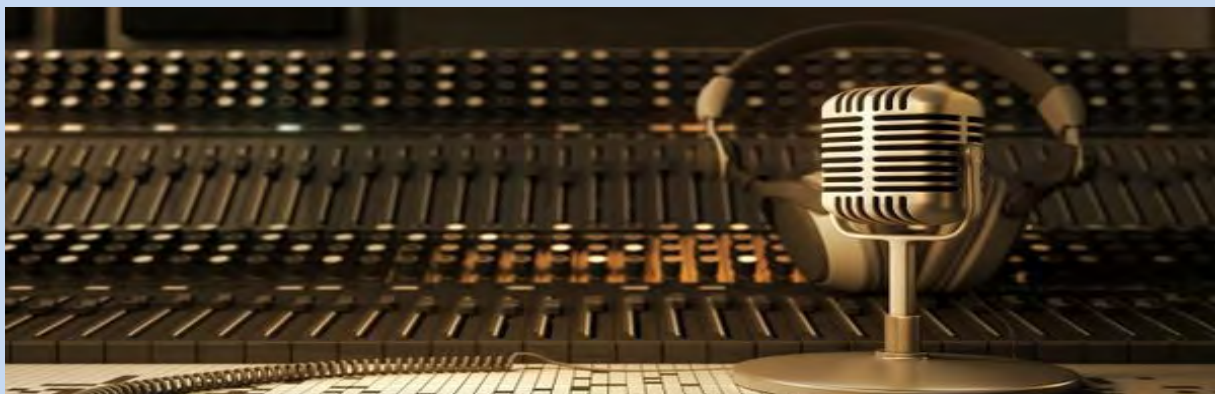

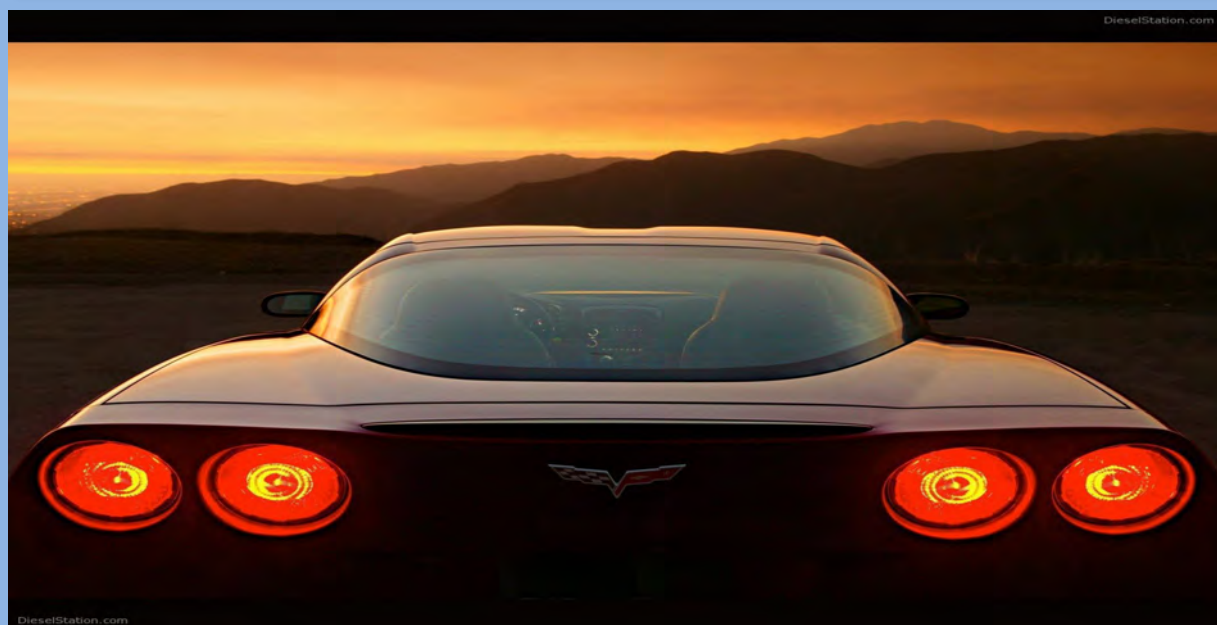

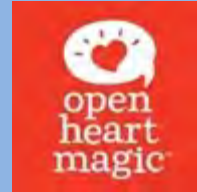

TWO MINUTE TECH TIP

A slight correction to last month's TMTT-

The oil fill levels I listed there for track use apply only to the C7.

C6 and C5 cars use different levels for track use. They can be found in your Owner Manual or I'll help you if you fall asleep after the first 20 pages of Why You Should Use a Seatbelt.

WHY DOES MY OIL LIFE DECREASE SO QUICKLY IN MY C7?

Like the C5 and C6, the C7 has an oil life monitor system that tells you when to change the oil. The system doesn't just count the miles, it counts injector pulses to see how many engine revolutions since the last change. Then, it adds fudge factors for things that wear out your oil more quickly- cold starts, high engine temperatures, etc. So although the system doesn't actually do a chemical analysis on your oil, it's very good at predicting the remaining "life" of your oil, and it has some safety margin built in. I and others have run my Mobil 1 down to 10% life on the indicator, then had it changed and analyzed by an oil lab. They always say that the oil would be okay to run down to 0% life.

On the C5 and C6, the Owner Manual tells you to change the oil after one year, regardless of the "life" remaining on the indicator. You want to do this, especially if you are still under the Powertrain Warranty or an Extended Warranty; failure to do the annual change could be grounds for Chevy to deny your engine warranty. On the C5 and C6, you have to keep track of the one year limit by yourself. (Suggestion- just drive the car enough that you are getting at least one oil change per year, that's more fun than keeping track of the calendar. Even during Covid times).

On the C7, the oil life monitor also reduces the remaining life based on the calendar. If you changed your oil and had the monitor reset to zero, then parked the car; six months later your oil life would show 50%, and a year later it would 0%. With no driving. If you are driving the car regularly, the oil life system does two calculations at all times- one is based just on the calendar, the other uses the usual combination of factors based on how you are driving the car. It displays whichever of the two calculations (time or driving) shows the lowest remaining oil life.

This is a very conservative way of calculating, but you can be confident that following the oil life indicator will not harm your engine and will also avoid violating the fine print of your warranty.

Our club offers a lot to our members (autocross events, weekend trips, social drives for dinners, etc). What is the best way Sunburst can enhance your Corvette ownership experience?

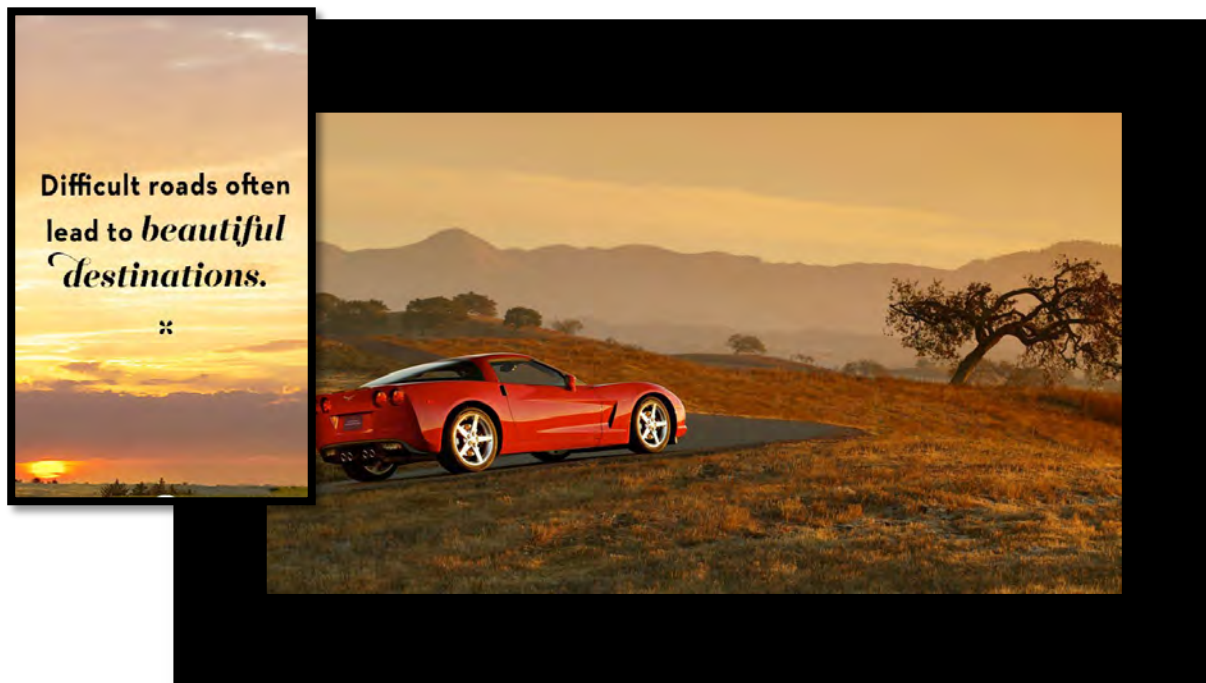
