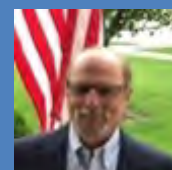

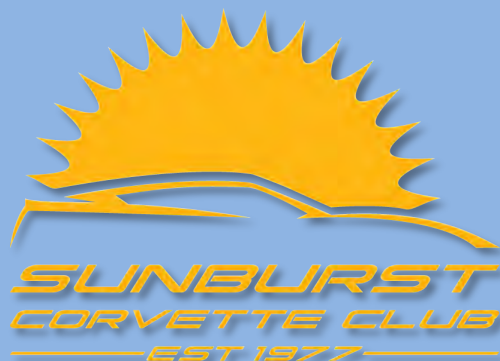

Message from The Governor

Greetings Sunburst Members,

Here's hoping that we've seen the final snow of the season. I know all of us have been itching to get past "the winter that never ends". Well, May should hold better wetter and the advent of the Cruise Nights and Car Shows. There are really only two Midwest Region competition events this month – a two day autocross event in Rantoul on May 18 & 19 and the Midwest Region Fundraiser autocross in Rantoul on May, 25, 26 & 27.

You may ask "why does the region host a fundraising event?" The region has expenses over the course of the year, the greatest of which are the annual awards banquet and the individual awards. (Remember my talks about points?) The revenue needs to come from somewhere. Prior to hosting a fund raising autocross weekend, the region used to charge a "head tax" for participating in every sanctioned event and that included car shows, rallies and autocross events. We've been fortunate to have avoided the dreaded head tax for over 10 years now. I mention this to encourage your participation, as a racer or helper, at the Memorial Day Autocross Weekend in Rantoul, this year.

The next meeting of the Midwest Region Governors will be held on May 3rd and 4th. Unfortunately, I won't be able to attend the meeting, due for family obligations. Once I receive the minutes from the proceeding I'll share them with you.

Don't forget to attend our annual Poker Run on June 1. Technically, the event is referred to as a Chance Rally. Sue and Lee Thorson have put together a great event that includes a tour of the S. E. Johnson facility in Racine, WI and the chance to win some cash by playing two poker hands. This is Sunburst's first NCCC sanctioned event and like most Sunburst events it starts with food at Brunch Cafe in McHenry. I look forward to seeing you there.

Finally, many members have asked about the NCCC Insurance and what benefit does it provide to our club and its members. Just recently, the Insurance section with FAQ's has been updated to reflect the current policy provisions we have with Legacy Insurance. I strongly suggest you check that section out. The second button from the top is FAQ link – very informative. By the way, since NCCC competition events were run so well last year our insurance rates dropped by \$6000 this year.

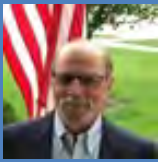

THE 6TH NATIONAL CORVETTE CARAVAN IS SLATED FOR AUGUST 28-31, 2019.

Often referred to as the world's largest moving automotive event, the National Corvette Caravan is a celebration of America's Sports Car, culminating in Bowling Green, Kentucky for the anniversary celebration of the National Corvette Museum. Hosted only once every five years, the next event is slated for Labor Day Weekend 2019 and will mark the Museum's 25th Anniversary. Leading the charge will be Jeffrey Duda of Hainesport, NJ, a Lifetime Member of the Museum and previous co-captain of the New Jersey 2014 and 2009 Caravans.

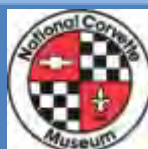

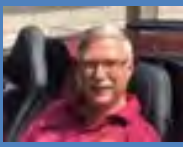

- ❖ Corvette Arrivals – Gary & Cathy Gembala – ZR-1 Museum delivery May 4.

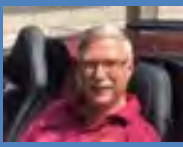
Officer Reports
