Greeting Sunburst Members,

August 2020

Well here we are in the middle of summer, all dressed up and nowhere to go! That's how I feel when I consider all of the NCCC events that have been cancelled. I completely understand the need for being cautious during this global pandemic. However, I'm still disappointed that car shows, cruise nights, autocrosses and rallies have disappeared from my calendar.

Speaking of cancellations – Late last week we made the decision to cancel the August Autocross events at McHenry County College. The college indicated we could run the event with restrictions. Unfortunately, those restrictions made it difficult, if not impossible to run a safe, fun and financially sound two-day event. The Governors of Sunburst, Northern Illinois Corvettes and Mad City Corvettes carefully considered all of our options and took into consideration the increasing Covid 19 infection rates in Illinois and Wisconsin. It was a tough decision, but we believe it was the safe option. Thanks go out to Mike Moushey for all his organizational work and to the many members that volunteered. No decision has been made, yet, for the autocross events in October.

Sunburst is still planning on hosting our annual Car Show on September 13th, at Martin Chevrolet, in Crystal Lake. We're hoping for a good turnout of cars, spectators and volunteers – all masked and appropriately social distanced. This is the major fund-raising event of the year and it would be great if every member of Sunburst brought their Corvette to the show and helped out in some way. The Governors of the Midwest Region of NCCC have been meeting regularly via teleconferencing. Since most of the competitive events have been canceled for the season, there really hasn't been a lot on our agenda. Although the national championships have been cancelled, there has been no decision regarding the regional championships. However, in my opinion, the regional championships should be cancelled as well. This would certainly take any strain off of the MWR budget and may even result in the cancellation of the annual MWR awards banquet. Again, the outcomes of one very different and trying year for everyone.

I hope that the month of August is pleasant for you and I look forward to any creative suggestions to get Sunburst members together safely.

Construction of the NCM Motorsports Park was started in June of 2013 and the facility was finished and ready for use in August of 2014, just over 12 months from the groundbreaking. Although the facility is part of the National Corvette Museum with many Corvette related events the facility is open to all makes and models of vehicles, including motorcycles. The facility is the official testing facility for the production Corvette program (in addition to GM's Milford Proving Grounds) and has supported Pratt & Miller Corvette racing program.

There is a large road course that can be split into two separated halves and can be run in five configurations. The longest version of the full course is 3.15 miles. Other configurations include track setup of 2.87 miles, 2 miles, 1.97 miles, and 1.1 miles. There is a alternative Le Mans inspired chicane that can be included in some of the track configurations.

The complex also includes an autocross/skid pad area that itself covers 21 acres, a huge paddock area, high-tech control tower, classrooms for racing instruction, a pavilion area, concession stands, a fueling station, and a high-speed karting track.

There are several ways to enjoy the Motorsports Park including several different types of experiences: Drive a Corvette; Drive Your Own Car; Driving Clubs; Autocross; Driving Coaching; Karting; and Motorcycling.

Drive a Corvette

- The Corvette Experience – Drive a C8 Stingray Z51 on the 3.2 mile 23 turn road course. Includes 3 – 20 minute on track lead follow session with 3 – 20 minute class room sessions.
- Corvette Touring Laps – Drive a C8 Stingray Z51 Corvette for 4 laps on the 3.2 mile road course.

Ride in a Corvette

- Hot Laps – Participate as a passenger in one of the track's corvettes track professionals for 2 laps on the 3.2 mile track.

Drive Your Car

- Touring Laps – Drive your own car with a lead/follow car for 4 laps on the 3.15 mile road course.
- High Performance Driving Instruction (HPDI) – A “101” on track program introducing new drivers to the recreational performance driving hobby.
- High Performance Driving Education (HPDE) – Learn, practice and apply advance car-control skills lead by highly trained classroom and certified in-car instructors. Learn vehicle dynamics, car control, cornering, braking and driving fundamentals.
- Driving Club – Become a member of the Driving Club at NCM Motorsports Park and get exclusive use of the track.
- Auto X – A straight up Autocross program for folks who want seat time. No class course work or trophies, just timed runs all day!

The NCM Motorsports Park C8 Z51 Corvette Experience



On a recent trip to Nashville I took the opportunity to stop at the Motorsports Park in Bowling Green to participate in the C8 Z51 Corvette Experience at the NCM Motor Sports Park.

The program includes 3 – 20 minute driver's meetings and 3 – 20 minute on track lead follow session. There were 6 participants in the class broken up into three driving groups of two students each.

The program was like other Corvette driving experiences I have participated in but in a much-condensed format. I had to keep in mind that this was not to get more track experience, or a demonstration of the full feature, functions and capabilities of the C8 but to only get in-seat driving experience in the new mid-engine C8 and for me an opportunity to compare it to my C7 Z06.

For the \$799 fee you get the driving experience, classroom sessions focused on the track, MSP Track corner review – breaking – acceleration point – breaking and turning landmarks – cornering speed etc. Helmets are included, although you can bring your own if you are so inclined, as well as lunch and a VIP tour of the National Corvette Museum. You do need to wear closed toed shoes and long pants, but you can wear short sleeved shirts. For a mere \$20 charge you can include a guest who can sit in on the class, have lunch and get the VIP Museum tour. Since the museum had only been open for a week after the COVID-19 closure the Museum VIP Tour was cancelled but we did get free access to a self-guided tour of the museum on our own.

Let me start with the track. I have driven many track days at about a half dozen tracks around the country and I have to say this is one of the most interesting. First, the configuration of the track for the C8 Experience is set for the Grand Full 3.2-mile-long track with 23 turns which is one of the longer tracks I have experienced (Road America at 4.05 miles with 14 turns the longest). There are a lot of elevation changes and a few blind corners. Until you get familiar with the track it is a bit interesting. All in all, a very nice track to get familiar with the C8 as it has just about any track condition you would want to experience.

The classroom sessions and the lead-follow experiences could have been better. The instructors all had a lot of track driving experience and one with GM development experience. I felt the class curriculum could have been more balanced between the features and functionality of the C8 and driving

techniques specific to the Motor Sports Park track. The classroom experience was headily focused on the track and how to drive it. I get it if you don't know how fast to enter a corner, where to break, where the car should be positioned coming out of a corner you could have a very bad and expensive day (the Vehicle Damage Waiver limit is \$10,000). But I was there to experience the C8, the track was just a necessary part of that experience.

The car is everything that you have probably already heard about. The interior is well laid out with everything in reach. The controls on the center console are easy to reach. I like the fact that the drive mode selector has a cover over the dial which prevents accidentally changing the drive mode. Seats are comfortable and visibility out of the windshield is great allowing much better perception and visibility of the front of the car, making it better for cornering. Acceleration is unbelievable, with an advertised 0-60 speed of 3 seconds, but felt very controllable. Cornering is different than the C7 Z06, with possibly a little understeer but coupled with the increased visibility very easy to accurately place the car into a turn. The car feels light and easy to control. One thing I really liked about the C8 is the electronic rearview mirror. The mirror itself is larger than the C7 but because of the camera and the resolution of the rearview mirror screen you have a much clearer and bigger view behind the car. The cabin is surprisingly quiet. You do not notice the engine is a few inches from your head and the exhaust sound is negligible in the cabin as well. The exhaust outside of the car on the C8 Z51 in track mode was also not as loud as the C7 Z06 in sport or track mode. Being an avid manual transmission fan, I was interested in how the automatic would be to drive. I used both the auto and manual paddle shift modes. As you have heard the transition shifts much quicker than you can manually. The transition does a great job of selecting the appropriate gear and down or upshifting based on the driving conditions. One thing I noticed in auto mode vs manual paddle shift mode is I selected a gear or two lower than the automatic transmission did in certain spots on the track. When they become readily available and I have the cash I would definably get one (a Z06 for me).

For me, the Motorsports Park C8 Z51 Corvette Experience was well worth the cost and provides an opportunity to drive the C8 in a way that you will not get in a standard test drive and you get access to the MSP track.

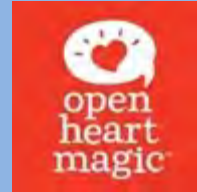

Fluid Swaps- A8 Transmission and Differential

Just a reminder that one free “Triple Flush” for your 2015-2019 **8 speed automatic** transmission fluid is covered under the Powertrain warranty, if your C7 was built before February 1, 2019. Model year 2019 ‘vettes made after that date already have the new style fluid and should not need to be flushed. Many other GM cars and trucks also use the same transmission and can get the free flush but the applicable dates may be slightly different.

The older fluid is prone to absorbing moisture from the air and producing a shuddering or jerking feeling from the tranny. Even if you haven’t experienced the problem, a free fluid flush is never a bad idea and may save you from having to pay for it yourself after your Powertrain warranty expires.

The Owner Manual on our C7 tells us to avoid track or racing events until 1,500 miles, and to take it easy on the first session. After that first event and every 24 hours of racing use, drain and refill the **differential**. Probably not many of us will need the 24 hour racing service, but some guys have a lot of fun...

Finally, the **engine oil level** has a recommendation for racing or track use. If you have the Dry Sump engine (Z51, GS, Z06, ZR1), for track use they recommend keeping the oil level up to ½ qt above the Full mark. For the basic Stingray without the dry sump, just keep the level at Full. Happy Motoring!

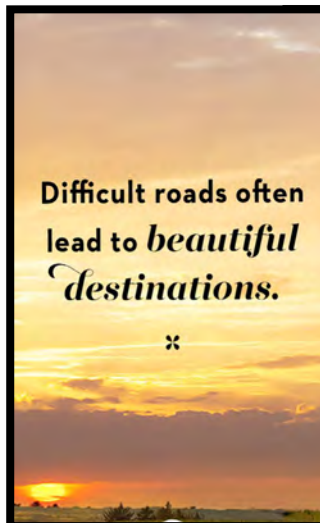

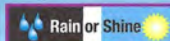

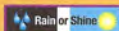
