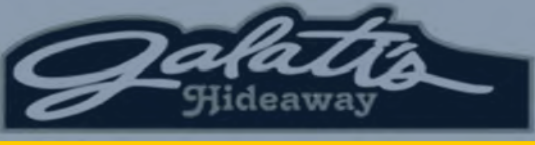

OFFICER DUTIES

Duties Of The President

The President shall be the executive officer and shall preside over all meetings of the Club and of the Board of Directors. He/she shall be an ex-officio member of all standing and special committees. He/she shall perform such other duties as usually pertain to that office of the President. He/she may call special meetings of members. He/she shall be authorized to sign all checks. He/she shall be a member of the Club for a minimum of two years before being elected.

Duties Of The Vice President

The Vice President, in the absence of the President, shall preside at all meetings of the Club and the Board of Directors. He/she shall also perform such other duties as usually pertain to that office or may be assigned him/her by the President. He/she shall also appoint members to certain standing Committees as provided in Article IX. He/she shall be authorized to sign all checks.

Duties Of The Secretary

The Secretary shall keep the records and minutes of the regular and Board meetings of the Club in a book kept for this purpose. He/she shall be authorized to sign all checks. He/she shall give all notices of meetings of the members required by law or these By-Laws.

Duties Of The Treasurer

The Treasurer shall receive, collect, and have custody of all monies, debts and obligations belonging to the Club, including dues. He/she shall receive all monies of the Club and deposit same in the Club account. He/she shall make all payments of Club debts upon approval of the Board of Directors. No obligation, debt, or other liability shall be incurred by the Treasurer without the specific approval of the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall develop the annual operating budget as provided in Article XII, Section 2, and shall give a report on the financial status of the Club at regular Club meetings and, if so requested, at any other meeting of the Board of Directors. All contracts, drafts, notes or other orders for payment of money shall be signed in the name of the Club by the Treasurer and approved by the President, Vice President, or Secretary.

Duties Of The Governor

The N.C.C.C. Governor shall serve on the Board of Directors. He/she shall represent the Club in all matters pertaining to N.C.C.C.

Message from The Governor

Greeting Sunburst Members,

For the first time since February 2019, Pat and I attended the NCCC Governor's meeting in St. Louis. It was great seeing a number of old friends and getting back to the business of NCCC. **Here are some of the highlights of the Midwest Region and National meetings:**

- MWR Governors will be voting on Board Members for 2022. Larry Pagliaro, long time Regional Executive is stepping down, as is Ray Bair, Regional Competition Director.
- NCCC now has 17,892 members
- Membership renewal process must be completed by November 15th.
- Nationally- Governors will be voting on rule book changes, which include limits on the number of sanctioned events that can be held in one day.
- NCCC gave out 7 scholarship this year and is considering increasing the number and amount of awards in 2022. There were only 14 applicants.
- The 2022 NCCC National Convention will be held in Atlantic City New Jersey from June 12 to the 17. Harrah's Casino and Convention Center will be host site.
- The 2021 convention, held in Cleveland, had 392 attendees and cleared \$41K. There were a number of controversies regarding some competitive events.

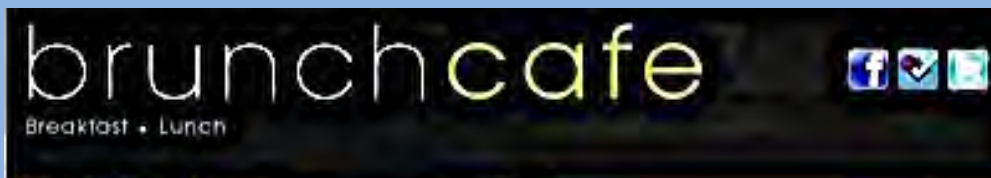
Midwest Region Governors have begun to put together the 2022 competition calendar. Sunburst is again planning on hosting an autocross weekend in August and joining with Northern Illinois Corvette Club to host an autocross weekend in October. We are still exploring other venues for racing.

On the weekend of October 16th and 17th, Sunburst is co-hosting an autocross weekend at McHenry County College. Just like our August events, we need your help to make this a safe and rewarding weekend. Our biggest need is for volunteer corner workers and we've found that a two to three hour commitment is all it takes, to help out. Bring your favorite camp chair and sunglasses, watch the racers and pick up a cone or two. Our volunteers in August will tell you they had a fun time. We will provide the necessary training, if you're a novice.

There are just a few weekends of competition events left in the 2021 season. Take advantage of the great fall weather and get out and enjoy your Vette.

National Corvette Museum Experience



Most of us have heard about the R8C Museum Delivery option that can be purchased when you order a new Corvette to pick your Corvette up at the NCM about 2 weeks after production, but did you know you could have the same experience if you did not order your new Corvette, purchased a used Corvette or have owned your Corvette for years.

Corvette owners have the opportunity to participate in the “NCM Experience” – a program that offers



owners a unique experience with their Corvette at the National Corvette Museum. Corvette owners can schedule a special visit to the Museum, where their Corvette receives an exterior cleaning and is then displayed on the floor of the Museum delivery area, similar to the highly requested R8C Program.

Participants in the NCM Experience are given a VIP Museum tour as part of the program, and are also given a one-year individual membership to the Museum, commemorative wall plaque, silver decal recognizing participation in the program, and an individual photograph in front of the Museum – and the experiences can also be viewed via the NCMs live [webcams](#).

Cost of the Experience program is \$500.00.

Program participants will also receive a numbered Flint brick, a dealer brochure for your model year Corvette (not all years available) and the opportunity to discuss maintenance tips and seek automotive advice from the NCMs expert staff mechanic. You will also have the opportunity to purchase special merchandise showcasing the “NCM Experience” logo, [bricks](#) in a special commemorative section, and build sheets/window stickers if available, during the program presentation.
