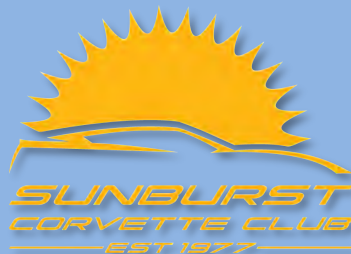

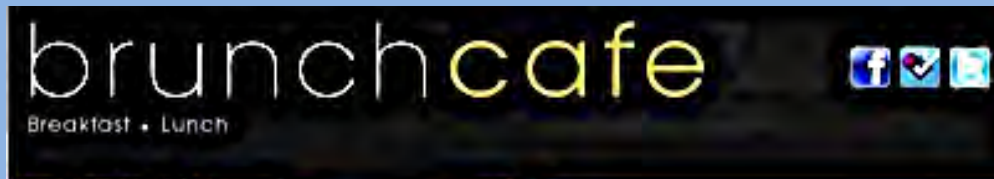
- NCCC Scholarships will open on 1/6/20 and the applications can be found on the NCCC website.

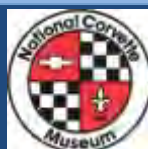

C7 PRODUCTION ENDS, LAST 2019 STINGRAY TO BE DELIVERED AT NCM

November 14, 2019 It's the end of an era – Thursday, November 14 was the last day of production for the C7 Corvette. The final car, a Z06, rolled off the end of the assembly line at approximately 3:10pm. The car was purchased at Barrett Jackson for \$2.7 million by Dan Snyder. Continued on next page...

But the 2nd to last car? That Corvette will call the National Corvette Museum home. The car is the last Stingray to be built and was purchased by Museum Lifetime Member and supporter Ivan Schrodt. Ivan will take delivery of the Corvette next Wednesday, November 20 at 2pm CT, and will then hand the keys over to the Museum in a ceremony on Corvette Boulevard. 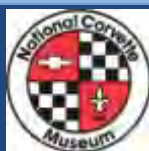
CHEVROLET CORVETTE STINGRAY NAMED 2020 MOTORTREND CAR OF THE YEAR

The first-ever production mid-engine Corvette represents the fastest, most powerful entry-level Corvette in the vehicle's 66-year history

The redefined Chevrolet Corvette Stingray won the 2020 MotorTrend Car of the Year award, earning the mid-engine masterpiece a top spot among the best vehicles the world has to offer for the third time in Corvette's history.

The coveted honor, previously awarded to Corvette in 1984 and 1998, was presented to Tadge Juechter, Corvette executive chief engineer and Michael Simcoe, General Motors vice president of Global Design, at an event featuring industry executives and celebrity guests at MotorTrend's headquarters in El Segundo.

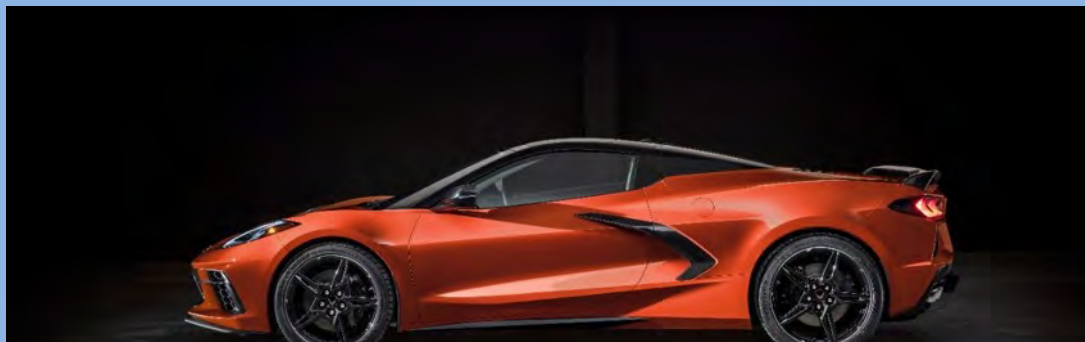

The reimaged icon boasts exotic proportions and a modern design inspired by racing and aeronautics to deliver unprecedented levels of quality, customization, technology and craftsmanship. Powered by the next-generation 6.2L Small Block V-8 LT2 engine, the 2020 Corvette Stingray packs 495 horsepower and 470 lb-ft of torque.

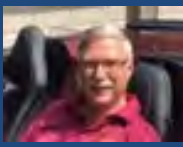

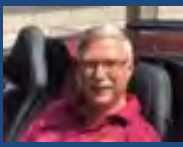

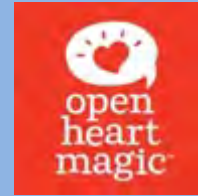

All tires lose some grip when it's cold outside, summer performance tires like those that come on the C5/C6/C7 lose a lot. Chevrolet recommends using winter tires for modern Corvettes below 40°F for better grip, and don't drive the C7 factory tires below 20°F to prevent cracking.

We've driven the Michelin AS3+ tires (All Season) tires down to -12°F, and in up to 3" of snow on level roads; without problems. They work well in summer unless you're spending your time on a track. They also last about 50% longer than the factory summer tires. Available in ZP (runflat) versions. An excellent touring tire.

On the C7, Weather Mode still allows the engine to make full power if you floor it. It makes the throttle less touchy and makes the stability "nannies" more sensitive to help keep you out of trouble. You must re-select Weather Mode each time you start the car, but it's a good thing to use any time that conditions (rain, snow, cold tires, etc.) reduce your traction, especially until your tires warm up.

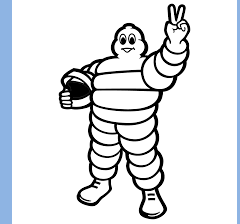

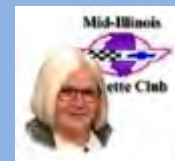
