# Message from The Governor

Greetings Sunburst Members,

December 2021

The holidays are here and it's time to string the Christmas lights on your Vette. It's also my last message of the year and it's been a very good year for Corvettes, Sunburst, the Midwest Region and the National Council of Corvette Clubs. In many respects 2021 found us back to a somewhat normal driving season, although there were some noticeable changes.

Pat and I attended the Regional and National NCCC meetings, in St. Louis in early December. In the Midwest Region, Linda Fairlamb was elected the new Regional Executive and Jeff Craig was elected the new Regional Competition Director. We will definitely miss the leadership of Larry Pagliaro and Ray Bair, who have stepped down from the RE and RCD positions, respectively. I'm sure Linda and Jeff will do a great job, but have "large shoes to fill". Governors have put together, what looks like, a great competition calendar for 2022. We'll have a better idea of what lies ahead at our February meeting. Of most concern, was the Region budget for 2022. Like most organizations, we saw costs increase and revenues decline. This will force governors to seriously look at cutting costs in order to avoid the "dreaded head tax" on all sanctioned events.

The national meeting was interesting to say the least. The big ticket item was proposed changes on the rulebook for 2022-2024. Competition Directors worked for two years reviewing and revising the rulebook. For some strange reason that escapes me, the rulebook changes needed to be voted on as a complete package. After a lengthy and heated discussion about parliamentary procedure the rulebook changes were defeated, primarily because of opposition to ONE of the proposed changes. From my perspective it defies logic.

I'd like to thank **Erin Risch** for handling the Sunburst and NCCC renewals with such efficiency. With **Gary Gembala's** help the process appeared to be convenient for members and relatively smooth. I was somewhat disappointed to see the number of members that didn't renew (I'll miss you), but encouraged by the new members (yeah!) we brought into the Sunburst ranks. I've been tracking Sunburst membership for 20 years and our average turnover is 20%, which we exceeded this year.

I'd like to give a big shout out to **Mike Moushey**, who worked tirelessly to put together two autocross weekends for Sunburst. Combined, those two weekends contributed over \$2000 to the Sunburst Treasury. The following Sunburst members will receive awards for their competition or worker points: **Matt Waters, Mike Moushey, Mike Stevens, Jim Downing, Karen Hottenrott, Mike Rosendahl, Julie Thomas, Dave Thomas and Joani Downing -CONGRATULATIONS**

Finally, I'd like to thank the Sunburst Board – **Dee Rosendahl, Loren Doppelt, Marilyn Roberts and Lee Thorson** – for providing outstanding leadership and direction for the Club. It sure made my job easier, as Governor.

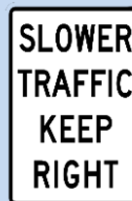

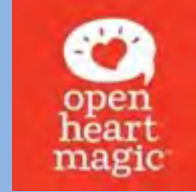

## DECEMBER 2021 TWO MINUTE TECH TIP

### How Far Can I Drive on a Flat Runflat?

There are really two questions here-

\*How far can I drive without ruining the tire?

and

\*How far can I drive without the tire coming apart?

If the tire has a typical puncture near the center of the tread (between the outermost and innermost tread grooves), or is leaking from a cracked rim; it normally can be repaired and you don't want to ruin it by driving too far. Different generations of Corvette have said different things about what is "too far", I've heard of runflats being ruined with as little as 5 miles driving flat, or going 30 miles and still repairable. If the tire is low on air (maybe 15-25 psi) but not flat, probably further.

Either way, shorter distance is better. If the leak is slow enough that you can air up the tire with that small compressor you keep in your trunk cubby (you have one, right?) or by stopping at gas stations, you can drive clear across the country if you air up every time the pressure drops below 30.

If you know that the tire is already ruined- a sidewall cut or puncture near the edge or big ragged hole; then you don't care about saving the tire, you just want to get home or someplace to buy a new tire. If you do it properly, you can drive a **long** way on a flat; I've heard of people going over 300 miles on a flat runflat! The tire will certainly be ruined, but you knew that already. Here's how to go long distance on a flat runflat-

\*Stop and decide on your goal- to get home, or to a tire store, or a hotel, etc? Call ahead, many shops will need to order the tire for you, that can take a day or two.

\*Drive at 50 mph or less. Drive in the slow lane with flashers on if necessary. You're still making better time than sitting beside the road.

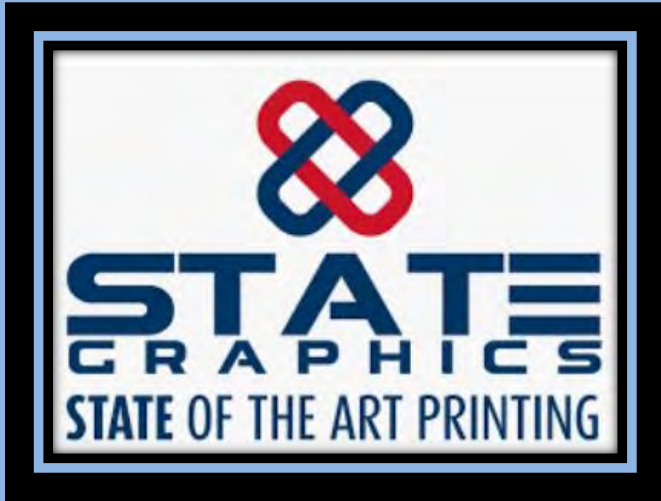
\*Drive like Grandma- go easy around the corners and plan to avoid hard braking.

\*Try to avoid potholes or bumpy roads that can ruin your wheels.

\*Stop every 30-60 minutes so you can inspect the tire for further damage, and to let the tire cool down- it will get hot, but should not be melting apart.

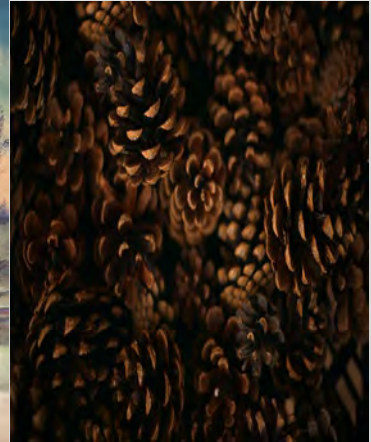







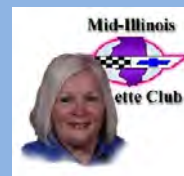
