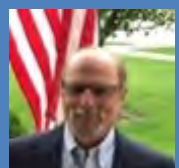

Greetings Sunburst Members,

I trust that you had a great holiday season, with lots of time spent with family and good friends. Even though there is a pile of snow on the ground now, before you know it, time will come to get your Vette out of storage.

The Governors in the Midwest region have been working hard at developing a competition schedule for 2019. There have been some significant changes in the making. A few new venues have been found for autocrossing in Pekin, IL and Columbus, WI. It appears that there may be fewer NCCC sanctioned car shows this year, and possibly a fewer rallies. You can easily check out the Midwest Region calendar, by going to mwregion.com and clicking on the Competition button. There you'll find a link to 2019 Traditional Schedule and Links to Flyers.

This year Sunburst will be organizing a Poker Run (Chance Rallye) on June 1st and will not be conducting a Fun Rallye. Our Autocross weekend on August 10 & 11 has been expanded to 7 events on both days. Finally, our Annual Car Show will not offer any NCCC sanctioned events. The car show committee decided to not be constrained by NCCC categories so that we can grow participation across all vehicle makes and models.

This will be a final reminder for the Midwest Region Banquet on March 9th. This is a great opportunity to hang out with other Corvette enthusiasts and celebrate the 2018 competition year. The cost is only \$35 per person and includes an open bar, and family style meal. The event will be held at the Crowne Plaza Chicago SW, in Burr Ridge. Rooms are available for \$109. See the flyer in this newsletter or go to the MWR website and click on the Social Calendar Button.

Hopefully, by now you've received your NCCC membership cards via the US Postal System. Let me know if you haven't. Bill Mumford has done a great job handling all of the renewal memberships as well as the addition of new Sunburst members. We work together to insure that Sunburst members have all of the benefits of being members of the NCCC.

If you are planning on trying out auto crossing this coming year, you may wish to apply for a competition number for the entire season. The cost is \$15 per driver and that insures that you will have the same number in all of the events in which you choose to participate. The process is simple:

Simply go to the link: [Assigned Regional Speed Event Number – New Number](#), complete the form on-line, print it out and send it in to Ray Bair, Regional Competition Director, with your check for \$15. Requests for NEW Numbers should be post marked between February 15 and March 15. The complete directions are on the form. Extend Warranties and C7 Automatic Transmission Problems

In November I spoke about the problems with the A8 transmission in the C7. GM has now come out with their latest fix, full details are not yet available but should be at your dealer soon. It appears this fix involves yet another version of the transmission fluid, and using a flushing machine to get all the old fluid out.

Since the A8 transmission in the C7 and other GM vehicles has been rather problematic, you should know that the transmission is covered under the powertrain warranty, which runs longer than the basic warranty. On our 2017, the powertrain goes to 5 years or 60,000 miles (whichever comes first). Earlier C7's may have a longer powertrain period but I can't confirm that.

Many of our members will sell/trade their car before that, and have no use for an extended warranty.

If you are considering an extended warranty:

The big players are GM with their Chevrolet Protection Plan (formerly called GMEPP), and Ally (which used to run the GM plan). There are other smaller companies ranging from "good" to "worthless", and I don't know enough to comment on them. GM plans cover a little more but also cost a bit more.

You must usually buy the extended warranty while still covered by the basic 3/36 warranty. You're buying duplicate coverage during that time but the cost per month/mile is less. Consider buying a month before your 3/36 expires.

Both plans can be sold by any dealer at any price they want and are good at any dealer, so shop around. Email me if you need details.

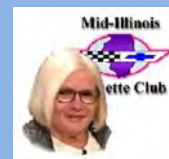

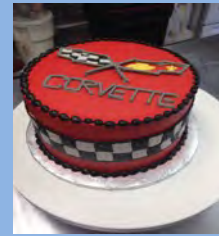
