Although the museum building is closed to the public the website offers many entertaining and educational learning opportunities to help fill your time as you harbor in your houses:

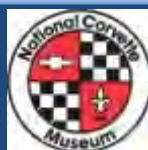

Dealer Pickup/Delivery Service

We've had lots of time on our hands and getting the 'vette ready for (hopefully) summer has gone well. There are some tasks we have done by a good dealer service department, and it turns out many/most of the shops are still open.

Here in Crystal Lake, the two dealers we use are Martin Chevrolet and Pauly Toyota. Both of them claim to do free pickup and return of your car, so you don't need to physically come into the dealership. Last week we tried Martin and it worked well.

Martin would have come to our house and driven the car to their shop, but we dropped it off there along with our summer tires/wheels transported in our beater. That afternoon they called and said the wheels/tires had been swapped and the other work completed, they returned the car to us and brought the winter tires/wheels that had been removed, in their truck. Paid by credit card over the phone. They parked the car in our garage and we just let it sit for several days so any virus would be neutralized by time.

We discovered that Paul had left a copy of GM Bulletin #06-00-89-029Q dated Apr 3, 2020 in our car. Six pages long. It's all about interior cleaning, but this latest version has some tips on the first page about what cleaners should protect against COVID-19, without damaging the car interior. Thanks!

Attention: This bulletin also applies to any of the above models that may be Export vehicles.

This bulletin has been revised to add an Attention statement to emphasize that this bulletin includes all Export Regions. Please discard Corporate Bulletin Number 06-00-89-029P.

Important: Based on U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendations, and to protect against COVID-19, disinfecting wipes can be used, but do not use scented wipes or wipes containing bleach. Products like Clorox Disinfecting (non-scented, no bleach) wipes can be used. These wipes have been shown in testing to be low impact on interior surfaces and coatings. Remove excess liquid before wiping surfaces, especially electrical and touch screen components. Wipes that are scented or contain bleach can cause chemical attack on interior surfaces and should not be used. Do not use any wipes or cleaners that show color transfer to the wipe or a change in appearance of interior surfaces when tested in an inconspicuous location, as those are indicators of chemical attack.

Note: General Motors recommends cleaning as directed in the Owner's Manual with mild soap and water, for most all interior surfaces.

To keep the vehicle interior looking the best, it should be cleaned often. It is important to keep the upholstery from becoming heavily soiled. The vehicle's interior can experience extreme heat, which can cause stains to set quickly. Lighter color interiors may require more frequent cleaning. Care should be taken because newspapers and garments may transfer color to the vehicle's interior.

Many of today's interiors are made with new low gloss materials. Permanent damage may result from using cleaners on ANY surfaces (interior trim, instrument panel, carpet, leather, vinyl and fabric) for which they are not intended. Using non-approved products can actually set the stain to the point that nothing can remove it.

Important:

- Do not use silicone or wax-based products or those containing organic solvents (such as naphtha, alcohol, etc.) to clean your vehicle's interior because they can alter the appearance by increasing the gloss in a non-uniform manner. The increase in gloss may cause annoying reflections in the windshield and even make it difficult to see through the windshield under certain conditions.
- Never use a STIFF brush or a brush that has been previously used with a harsh chemical. This can cause damage to the vehicle's interior surfaces.
- Use only mild, Neutral-pH cleaners. Avoid laundry detergents or dishwashing soaps with degreasers. Using too much cleaner will leave residue that

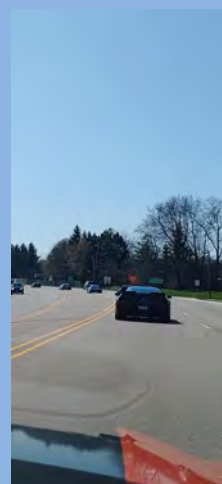

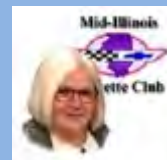
