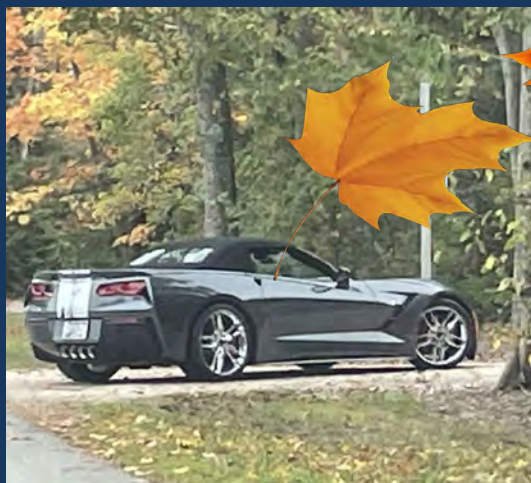

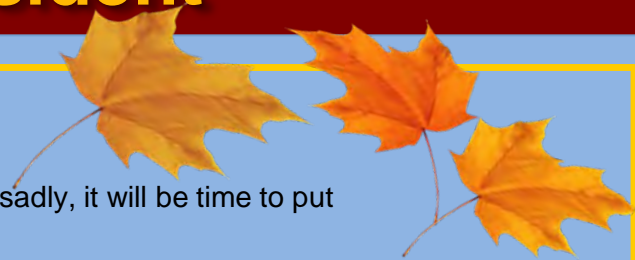

Greetings Sunbursters,

Time flies when you're having fun! It seems like it was just yesterday when we were celebrating the return of competition to the Midwest Region of NCCC. Now, here we are at the end of the season and we're getting ready to tuck our Vettes away for the winter. The competition season ended with a very successful autocross event held at McHenry County College, hosted by Northern Illinois Corvette Club, Northern Rays, Windy City and Sunburst.

Although only a few Sunburst members participated in NCCC events this year, Sunburst fared well when compared to the 27 other clubs in the Midwest Region. **Sunburst** accumulated 2321 pts, through members' participation in autocross, rallyes, car shows and working those events. That was good enough to land us in **9th place (top third) in the Midwest Region**. To put that into perspective, Windy City accumulated 6741 pts this year (here I go with points again).

Out of 254 male competitors, **Sunburst** ended up like this:

NCCC Governors have begun our planning for the 2022 competition season. As it stands now, Sunburst will be hosting our "Seat of Our Pants" autocross at MCC on **August 6th and 7th**. We will also be involved with NICC for their "Wrap Up the Season" event, at MCC, on **October 15 & 16th**. Mark your calendars and get ready to race or help out. Not only are these events fun but they are major fundraising events that support the operation of Sunburst and help support our designated charities.

NCCC Governors will be meeting in St. Louis on Veteran's Day weekend. Pat and I are planning on attending both the national and regional meetings. One of the top items on the agenda are changes to the NCCC rulebook for 2022. From my perspective, the most significant issue is the recommendation to limit clubs to holding a maximum of 5 sanctioned events in any one day. I see this an unnecessary limitation on clubs, for no solid reason. Clubs have the ability and right to limit their event rights now, if they choose. The limitations, if passed would limit fund raising events, without reducing overhead and a significant increase in registration fees. You'll see the results of the voting in the December newsletter and in my report at the December membership meeting.

Pat and I hope that you and your family have a wonderful Thanksgiving. I know that we are soooo thankful to be part of Sunburst and to have soooo many wonderful Corvette friends through the Club. Please take care of yourselves, stay healthy and treasure the moments that fill your heart.
