<u>Founders' Day Parade in Algonquin</u> – July 27, 2024 – Mike & Dee Rosendahl – Dee hasn't received a lot of information yet from Algonquin. Staging for the parade will be at 9:00 am, and the parade starts about 11:00 am. She'll present more information as it becomes available.

IMSA Races at Road America, August 4, 2024 – Scott Schulz – Scott indicated that GM sponsors the Corvette Corral, and he mentioned that it is a good idea to purchase your tickets in advance. Tickets are \$70/person. Scott will plan a route to get to Road America. The event starts around 7:30 or 8:00 am so we will need get there early in order to park in the Corvette Corral. The event itself starts between 8:00 and 8:30. Road America does have hop-on-hop-off transportation to get to other parts of the track.

<u>Autocross – August 10 & 11, 2024</u> – Mike Moushey & Mike Stevens – Mike Moushey indicated that this is being held at McHenry County College. One car is on the course at a time, and you can drive as fast or as slow as you want. If you don't want to drive the autocross yourself, the participants will have ride alongs. Mike will need volunteers to work the event.

7th Annual Corvette Caravan, August 29-31, 2024 – Scott Schulz – Scott mentioned that the Club caravan will be leaving August 27 and that this is the celebration of the 30th Anniversary of the Museum.
